Price Change Petroleum Products

The Government of St. Maarten regulates the prices of petroleum products by imposing a maximum price at which wholesalers and retailers can sell these products on St. Maarten. Due to the ongoing developments on an international level, the prices of crude oil have experienced adjustments. Taking into consideration that our local prices follow the international trend, our prices for ULG will also experience an adjustment. Given the aforementioned, the general public is hereby informed that as of **Wednesday November 12, 2014**, the **maximum consumer price** of the following petroleum product has been adjusted as follows:

Diesel price remains as is	2.006 Naf/liter
